Having built nearly one hundred ten Pulsifer Hamptons, the methods, materials, and equipment are much the same as those I have used for almost forty years. Though, with each Hampton I build, I am continually adding details, developing techniques, and making improvements.

When you come into my shop, there's no salesman between you and the boat. You will be able to see, smell, and feel the raw materials that I use to build the wooden boats for a lifetime of pleasure and service for you and your family.

I build the Pulsifer Hampton using the traditional strip planking method. These wooden boats are constructed of local white pine, oak, and cedar, hand selected and sawn to my specifications.

As a boat builder, I look forward to each new hull with excitement and anticipation. The process – the entire boat building experience – is as rewarding as the finished product. Building the Pulsifer Hampton, I have the opportunity to get to know each of my customers personally. Together, we share in the pleasure of constructing a boat that is hand crafted to provide a lifetime of enjoyment and service.

You'll pass Bowdoin College, the former Parkview Hospital, and Pleasant Hill Road before coming to fork of Maquoit Road and Mere Point Road. Bear left on Mere Point Road and proceed to 642 Mere Point Road. Look for a large mailbox on ri

ght with the name "Pulsifer". Turn right and go down gravel drive to shop. S low, No Wake.
